## Registration Guidelines

4. Check all course offerings and carefully read the descriptions of those classes you are interested in taking.
5. All students are required to sign up for a total of 6 credits. Music, Newspaper, Yearbook, SOAR and Student Government are by application only and will be automatically added to your schedule if you are accepted.
6. **Do not sign up for classes you do not intend to take next year.** Schedule changes are very difficult to obtain because the Master Schedule is built on student requests.
7. **Math will be assigned.**
8. Students testing below grade level in reading or math will automatically be placed in a supplemental reading or math class.
