A TI-83+ or TI-84 calculator is required for all math classes. Some prerequisites may be waived by permission of the instructor. The Math department is dedicated to ensuring that every Horizon student graduates with a strong background in the fundamentals of algebra, geometry, and statistic. Math courses for all 9th grade students will be assigned based on District and Middle School data.
